I. Call to Order and Opening Prayer

IV. Prior Meeting Minutes Approval

The meeting continued with a review of the previous month's minutes. It was suggested in future minutes to list members not present. Steve Sale moved, and Jack Sartin seconded the motion for approval of the February 17, 2026 meeting minutes. The minutes were approved by a unanimous vote.

V. Finance Committee

Jerry Knight, Treasurer

- a) The Financial Statements for the month ending February 28, 2026 were presented including a Financial Summary Report. In a discussion of the expenses, it was moved by Hampton Burwick and seconded by Steve Sale that the cost of the church sign refurbishment should come from the capital improvement fund. The motion passed unanimously.
- b) Audit Committee Formation. Tom Files will chair the Audit Committee and work will begin after Easter.
- c) Attendance Reports was presented and is attached. The individuals with only first names listed had temporary name badges but did not sign the Red Book. It was also suggested the report include those who have affiliated with St Thomas in the last period.

VIII. Mission – Outreach Committee

This Lent "Don't Give UP – Just Give" campaign has been successful, with two more weeks remaining. Blessing Bags with the Cathedral of Hope will take place Saturday March 21st at 10:30 am. Lee Swift suggested and created door hangers to announce the Holy Week Schedule to be distributed at neighborhood homes Saturday March 21st. Other upcoming events are the Pentecost social with dessert auction; and a plan to collect school supplies.

IX. Building & Grounds

Steve Sale, Junior Warden

The water use report is found in the agenda. Water costs are down about \$500 from the prior month. Last month a tree collapsed on the Parish Hall and cost \$1400 to remove (under the \$1500 threshold that requires Vestry approval). It is estimated to cost \$11,020 for necessary tree trimming. The last tree trimming was three years ago but the work can be preformed in segments. Steve is working on getting estimates to clean the windows and gutters. The estimate to replace both water fountains in the Parish Hall is \$2,253. It was moved by Hampton Burwick and seconded by Tom Files to use Capital Improvement funds to cover the cost. The motion passed unanimously. The parking log striping is on the agenda as well as concrete repairs outside the Parish Hall. The B&G Committee consists of Steve Sales, Jami Mifflin, John Billingsley and Harmon Duke.

- **Altar Guild** (Joe DeuPree) Two new individuals interested.
- **Greeters/Ushers** (Hampton Burwick) There was dissuasion regarding the "Welcome Ambassador Table" and how well it is working in greeting and capturing visitor information.

- **Kitchen/Social:** (Jami Mifflin) Planning the Chile CookOff for Wednesday April 29th at 630 in the Parish Hall.
- **Lectors (Readers)** (Jack Sartin) Have Readers through the end of April.
- **Music** (Joe DeuPree) Palm Sunday will be the debut of the new organ with a recital in the afternoon at 1:00.

It was suggested each ministry/guild have a display table on rotating Sundays to promote those ministries to the congregation.

Close Enough to Care

Core Idea

When the way we see people changes, the way we care for them changes.

The work of this talk is simple but profound: Making the intangible tangible —bringing visibility, humanity, and dignity to what has become unseen, normalized, or reduced to categories.

Why This Matters

Human suffering does not fit into one category
So care cannot stay in one category either.

A Key Insight from Science

Neuroscience shows: The brain is shaped by repeated experience (neuroplasticity)

Empathy is not fixed—it develops through encounter

The more we encounter others' lived realities:

the more we understand

the more we care

the more our brain is formed for compassion

Proximity doesn't just inspire compassion— it builds our capacity for it.

The Mission, Clarified: "Bringing you close enough to care."

This is not just a value—it is a process:

Distance → abstraction → indifference

Proximity → encounter → empathy → action

Proximity is not just morally significant. It is neurologically formative.

Faith Connection

This pattern is reflected in: The Good Samaritan, The Incarnation

God comes close enough to care.

Who We Are

Every person is created in the image of God

Every encounter holds spiritual significance

When we truly see another person, we encounter someone who bears the imprint of the Creator.

The Deeper Truth

We are made for: Empathy → Encounter → Transformation through relationship

Distance allows indifference.

Proximity awakens empathy.

God comes close enough to care.
And in His image, we are **created** to do the same.

Meditative Reflection Questions

1. Where in my own life have I seen something “intangible” become real—where understanding a person’s story changed the way I saw or cared?
2. Who might God be inviting me to come closer to—someone whose experience I do not yet fully see or understand?
3. What realities in our community might I be unintentionally overlooking because they have become familiar, normalized, or distant?
4. When have I experienced someone truly seeing me—not as a role or responsibility, but as a whole person? What made that possible?
5. If God comes close enough to care, what might it look like for me to reflect that same posture—in my leadership, my relationships, and my daily interactions?

Gracious and loving God,

You are the One who draws near— who sees us, knows us, and calls us by name.

Open our eyes, we pray, to behold one another as bearers of your image.

Where we have kept our distance, draw us closer.

Where we have overlooked what is unseen, make us attentive.

Where we have forgotten the dignity of another, renew our vision.

Form in us hearts of compassion, minds that seek understanding, and lives shaped by your mercy.

Teach us to come near as you have come near to us— to see, to understand, and to love.

And in drawing closer to one another, draw us ever closer to you;

through Jesus Christ our Lord.
